**Dry Washing**—fine soil blown away, leaving the gold.

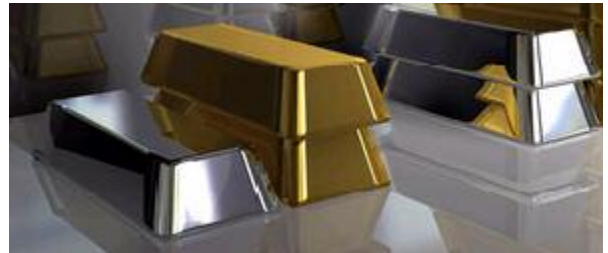
**Knife Claims**—gold dug from crevices with knife, or spoon.



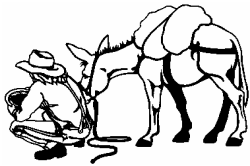

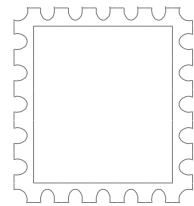
