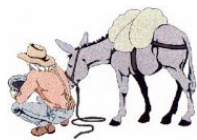

This release contains the entire agreement between the parties hereto, and the terms of the release are binding and contractual.

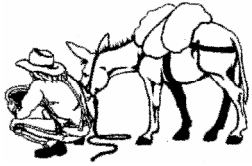

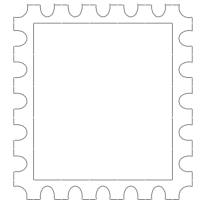
